Applications for Entry to Lower Kindergarten for Children born in 2015 for Entry in September, 2019

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

Due to the extremely large number of applications received by CCKG each year for the limited number of School places available in the entry year, it is necessary for the School to apply strict rules for the processing of applications. These rules are set out in detail below. We regret the need for the strictness of the rules, but they are necessary in order to administer the application process properly and smoothly.

The responsibility for the submission of application forms and compliance with the rules set out rests with the applicants and CCKG accepts no liability or responsibility whatsoever in respect of such applications. Applications that do not meet the necessary age and documentary requirements cannot qualify as valid applications and will be disqualified without notice. We also wish to point out that the submission of an application form does not guarantee an invitation to interview.

- 1) Application forms must be submitted **between 9.00am – 11.00am on MONDAY, OCTOBER 15 or TUESDAY, OCTOBER 16 IN PERSON** at the Kindergarten. Applications will only be accepted by hand **on the days and time stipulated**. It is NOT possible to accept applications submitted by post or by any means other than in person.

Inclement Weather

Should a number 8, or higher typhoon signal, or a black rainstorm warning be in effect one hour before the scheduled time to submit application forms on either day, the acceptance of application forms will be extended to Thursday, October 18th.

Please include for submission:

- a) Application Form (with a recent photograph of the child glued to the form).
- b) Two stamped, (\$3.00) **self-adhesive**, self-addressed, DL size (22cm x 11cm) envelopes with your child's name and date of birth on the front at the left hand bottom corner.
- c) Copy of the child's Birth Certificate.
- d) Copy of the child's Baptism Certificate and proof of Church attendance from Minister of Church attended (if applicable)

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- 2) An administration charge of \$40 (FORTY), payable by cheque only, will apply to each form on submission. Cheques should be made payable to 'Christ Church Kindergarten' with the applicant's name, date of birth, and the cheque account holder's mobile telephone number, written clearly on the back. Please make sure there are no typos on the cheques. We will be unable to process the Application if the cheques are returned for any reason.
- 3) Please fill in the form carefully and accurately. No corrections can be made after the School receives the application. Attach all documents to the application form with a paper clip (please do not staple). See attached sheet for details.
- 4) CCKG is part of Christ Church, Kowloon Tong and we are particularly pleased to receive applications from families who regularly worship at Christ Church. However, please note that giving false information about this or any other matter will result in the application being rejected.
- 5) Only those children born between **January and December, 2015** will be considered. Children born in other years are ineligible to apply. Please note that the School will not take responsibility for any inconvenience, expense etc., caused to ineligible applicants who submit application forms.
- 6) CCKG is an Anglo-Chinese School and the medium of instruction is English. All interviews for admission will be conducted primarily in English.
- 7) Please note that admission to CCKG does not guarantee admission into any particular primary school including Diocesan Preparatory School, Diocesan Boys' Primary Division or Diocesan Girls' Junior School.

Please Note:

Applicants invited to interview will be notified by post of their interview time during the first week of December. Please do NOT contact the School about interview times before then. However, if you have not received any information regarding your child's time for an interview by **Monday, December 10, 2018** then, and only then, please contact the Kindergarten.

Due to the large number of applicants, we regret we cannot entertain any requests for changes in the time or date of interviews, or a change of address during the interview process.

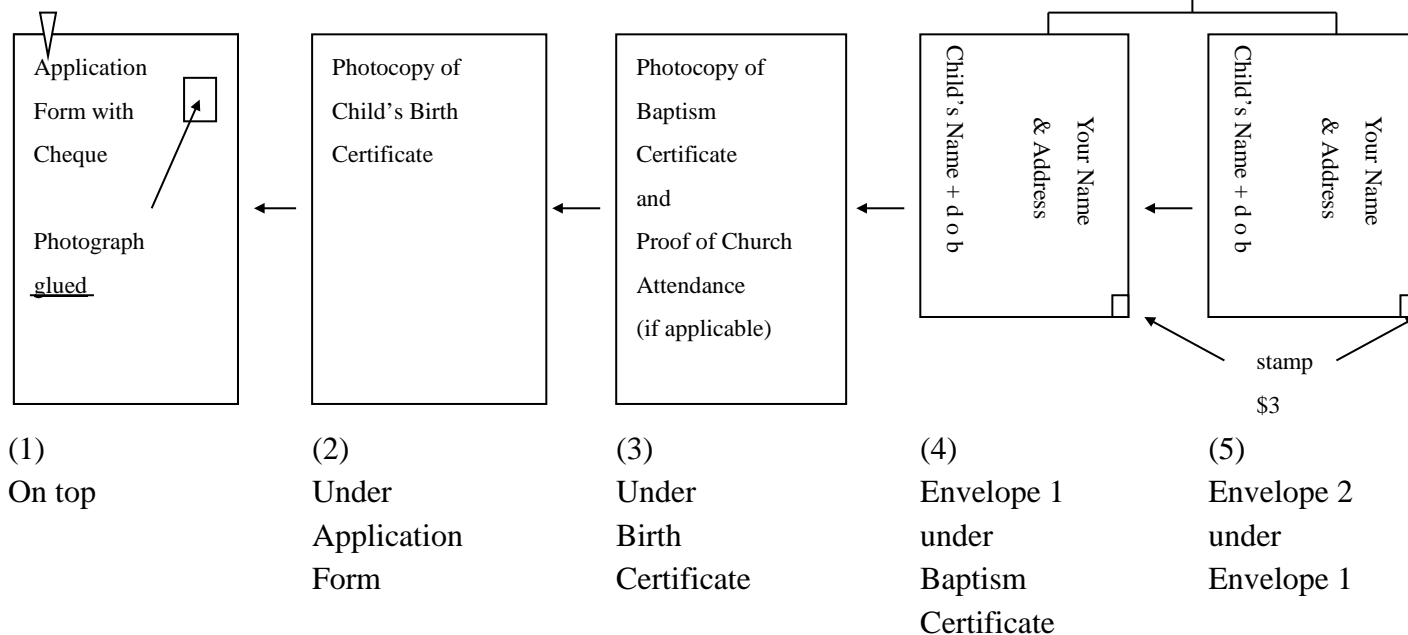
Application Forms are processed according to the child's month of birth, please give the child's NAME and DATE OF BIRTH in any communication with the School.

Paper clip (top left side) used.

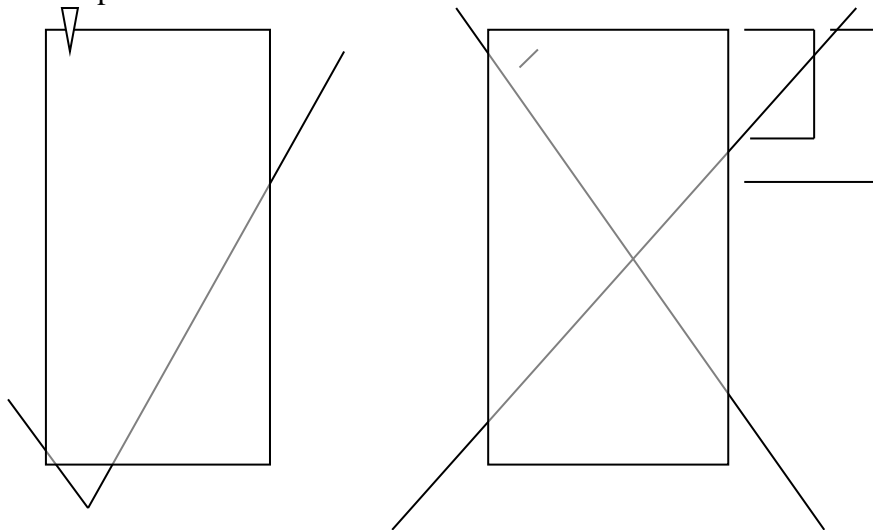
(DO NOT staple)
